



Housing Security: System Findings

1. The system lacks common purpose, language, and shared perspective of the whole.
2. System information is not flowing to the community.
3. Organizations are not effectively collaborating.
4. There are gaps in understanding about system capacity, resources, and community needs.
5. There is ineffective analysis of system information.
6. The system is not driven by lived experience experts and is influenced by a select group of stakeholders with power.
7. There is system stagnation due to a culture of perfection.
8. While there is an abundance of organizational creativity and innovation, there is a lack of system creativity and innovation.
9. The system holds extreme racial disparities.

Housing Security: Assets to Build On

1. There is an abundance of organizational creativity.
2. Data capabilities and efficacy is sharpening.
3. Existence of mutually reinforcing activity (Day One grant and Fulton Manor project).
4. New framework from CivicLab that's being scaled to the entire housing security work.
5. Teams worked together through various stages of ambiguity.
6. Conversations were centered around inequity.
